Departure is from the Opatija harbor at approximately 5:00 PM. From there, you’ll be taken to the fishing grounds near the sunken “Striker”, where the calm waters and stunning coastal views provide the perfect setting for an evening escape.

The experience is fully private and tailored for small groups, ensuring a personalized and relaxed atmosphere throughout the trip. Whether you are an experienced angler or trying fishing for the first time, our knowledgeable local fishermen will provide expert assistance, all necessary equipment, and attentive support to make your experience both enjoyable and rewarding. As the sun gently descends toward the horizon, you’ll find yourself immersed in an atmosphere of quiet wonder, surrounded by open waters, golden light, and the silent legacy of a century-old ship below.

Return is scheduled for approximately 9:30 PM. A transfer to hotels is available upon request at a fixed price of 80 € per group. The excursion requires a minimum of two participants and can accommodate up to four guests in total. The price per person is 130 €. This experience is ideal for families, friends, or anyone seeking a special way to connect with the sea, nature, and a touch of history.
